There are two instances where a vehicle can be regarded as 'not available for private use'. They are:

1. If you have been away on a business trip, or taken a leave period, where the vehicle and keys were stored at your place of work.
2. The vehicle was having repairs completed, and it was in the hands of a garage for more than 24 hours. (This does not include a routine service).

You can only claim days unavailable if you do not have custody or control of the vehicle for a full 24 hour period.
